## **Temporary Operating Procedures and Rules**

#### Effective Saturday, April 18, 2020

This is a notice to all Members of Corpus Christi Gun Club (CCGC or the Club) to let you know that in order for the Club to operate during the "Stay at Home/Social Distancing" orders issued by Nueces County, certain changes in CCGC Operating Procedures and Rules are required to remain in compliance with those orders. Therefore, the Board of Directors has developed the following Temporary Operating Procedures and Rules that will be in effect for the duration of the current situation and for as long as "stay at home/social distancing" orders are in place for Nueces County. All members will be required to sign a new Waiver and Release Agreement prior to entering the CCGC premises after Friday, April 17, 2020.

### **Temporary Operating Procedures and Rules**

The gates will be closed and locked when the club is closed.

The Club closed Mondays and Fridays.

**Hours of Operations**:

<u>Clubhouse:</u> Tuesday-Thursday 2 to 4 pm

Sat/Sun 9:00 am to 1:00 pm

**Shotgun Fields and Sporting Clays**: Tues-Thursday 2:00 pm-6:00 pm

Sat/Sun: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm

<u>Pistol/Rifle ranges:</u> Tues-Thursday 2:00 pm-6:00 pm

Sat/Sun: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm

The front gate will be locked at all other times until removed or modified by the Board of Directors.

#### **Operating Procedures/Rules:**

- Everyone must keep CDC recommended social distancing on all venues while at the Club. Social distancing requires all individuals, including shooters, to remain at least six foot (6') apart at all times, unless shooting with family members that live in the same household.
- Members only No guests or non-members will be allowed until further notice.
- Credit/debit card sales only No cash transactions
- Only one (1) member is allowed to be in the clubhouse at a time. Please conduct your business and exit promptly. Please do not linger. Everyone entering the clubhouse will be required to have, and to wear a face mask or bandana covering their mouth and nose.

# Temporary Operating Procedures and Rules (Continued)

- No competitions or other events will be held until further notice.
- Only one (1) individual will be allowed on a golf cart, unless all live in the same household. Golf Carts will be sanitized after each person's or family's use.
- Social Distancing will be required on the skeet and trap fields at all times. Not more than four (4) shooters will be allowed on a skeet field at any one time, and not more than five (5) shooters will be allowed on a trap field at any one time. Other members waiting their turn to shoot must be at least six feet (6') apart at all times including when standing under the canopies.
- Not more than four (4) members may be at a shooting station at any time on the sporting clay course. The shooter in the shooting cage and the puller must remain six feet (6') apart and the two (2) other shooters must remain in close proximity to their carts and at least six feet (6') apart until it is their time to shoot.
- Users of rifle and pistol bays/ranges and buildings must only use every other station, leaving an empty stall/table between users. Shooters to remain at least six (6') apart at all times, unless shooting with family members that live in the same household.
- Anyone that has travelled to a city or state as identified by Gov. Abbott as a "hot spot" should refrain from coming to the club. If you are not feeling well or have been exposed to anyone who is ill, please do not come to the club. If you have questions, please feel free to call the office at 361-852-1212.

THE CCGC WILL BE ABLE TO OPERATE DURING THE COVID-19 CRISIS ONLY IF ALL OF THE MEMBERS FOLLOW AND ADHERE TO THE GUIDELINES AND RULES NOTED ABOVE. MEMBERS WHO VIOLATE THESE RULES ARE RISKING THEIR OWN SAFETY AND THE SAFETY OF THE OTHER MEMBERS AND THE STAFF, AS WELL AS CREATING LIABILITY FOR THE CLUB.

MEMBERS WHO VIOLATE THESE RULES AFTER HAVING BEEN WARNED WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RETUN WITHOUT BOARD APPROVAL.

The Standard CCGC rules of the Corpus Christi Gun Club continue to be in full force and effect. In the case of a conflict between the CCGC Standard Club rules and these Temporary Procedures and Rules, these Temporary Procedures and Rules supersede.
