## **CCGC Sporting Clays rules:**

- 1. Eye and ear protection is **REQUIRED** on the sporting clays course for everyone (shooting and non shooting at all times while on the Sporting Clays course.
- 2. All non CCGC members must sign a liability waiver (on an annual basis).
- 3. All posted signs must be obeyed.
- Shotgun shells may not exceed <u>1-1/8 oz.</u> shot. <u>Shells may include 7-1/2, 8, 8-1/2 and 9 shot</u> <u>only</u>. No shot larger than 7-1/2 may be used. Participants are responsible for providing their own shells. No more than two shells may be loaded into your gun at any one time, regardless of magazine capacity.
- 5. All Shotguns must have a barrel length of 26 inches or longer.
- 6. Gun actions will remain open at all times on the premises except when on post ready to fire. When the gun is loaded, keep gun pointed down range at all times. Gun actions will be open and shells removed when changing posts.
- 7. If your gun malfunctions (fails to fire or jams for mechanical reasons), keep muzzle down range at all times while opening action. A shooter will NOT be allowed to make gun repairs while in the post.
- 8. No choke changes will be allowed once a shooter begins shooting on post.

## 9. OBSERVE THE NRA GUN SAFETY RULES:

- A. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- B. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- C. Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.

## 10. WHEN USING OR STORING A GUN, ALWAYS FOLLOW THESE NRA RULES:

- A. Know your target and what is beyond.
- B. Know how to use the gun safely.
- C. Be sure the gun is safe to operate.
- D. Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
- 11. May not drink alcohol prior to or during shooting'
- 12. Disruptive activities, such as loud music or horseplay, are not permitted.
- 13. FOR ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18: They must be accompanied by an adult at ALL times. The responsible adult will closely supervise their shooting and firearms handling and will be responsible for the minor's actions. Must be 18 or older and have a current valid driver's license to be allowed to operate a vehicle or cart on the sporting clays course.
- 14. **Speed limit for carts.** Carts must be operated at a safe speed, kept under control and <u>kept on</u> <u>the cart path or improved parking pull out and areas at all times</u>. After first warning user will have permit to drive a cart revoked for up to one year depending on the severity of the offense and attitude displayed.
- 15. Only golf carts or sporting carts are allowed on the course, no automobiles or trucks.
- 16. Except when shooting on a designated station, NO loaded shotguns may be carried on CCPRC Sporting Clays property. All guns shall be in a closed case or carried or resting with safety on, unloaded chamber open or broken down, in full display of being safe. Only vertical gun racks may be used on carts to transport shotguns. No rifles are allowed on the course.
- 17. Firearms not on the firing line must have their actions open, be broken down, in a gun rack, unless the firearm is cased. Uncased guns carried behind the firing line should have their actions open or be broken open.
- 18. At no time are participants allowed to load, adjust or repair trap machines. In the event a machine or other equipment is not working the user is to call club house to inform CCPRC staff of station number and problem. At no time are any users allowed down range of a shooting station.
