

## **Corpus Christi Gun Club Requirements for All Shotgun Instructors**

Shotgun instruction guidelines for reserving fields/scheduling lessons and teaching at Corpus Christi Gun Club (CCGC) shotgun fields. Any violation of the following requirements may result in revocation of membership and/or loss of access to CCGC facilities.

The following is subject to field availability and does not include times when CCGC has a registered shoot, a fun shoot or a private/corporate event that requires the use of shotgun fields.

All lessons will be scheduled 48 hours in advance with the club manager and recorded on the planning calendar in the Clubhouse by the manager. Availability will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. Even when there is no financial gain by instructor lessons must be scheduled as they tie up a field. It is our policy that not more than one instructor be present at the same time on the skeet/trap/five stand fields due to our capacity for members. It is acceptable to have one instructor on the skeet/trap/five stand fields and another instructor on the sporting clay course.

For members and non-members (who have a liability waiver on file in office prior to lesson start, must sign a new one each year).

Depending on availability instruction may occur as follows:

- Tuesdays: 9:00 am to 7:00 pm August 1 to December 31, 9:00 am to 5 pm Jan 1 to July 31 (4H season, unless a group lesson of 3 or more Nueces County 4H shooters are in the lesson and the head 4H coach and CCGC manager both approve of a field for this purpose during their practice night)
- Wednesdays: 9:00 am to 10:30 am and 1:30 pm to 7:00 pm (10:30 to 1:30 is the club's scheduled maintenance time for shotgun fields)
- Thursdays: 9:00 am or sunup to 5:30 pm
- Saturday and Sunday: 12:30 pm to posted close\*  
\*Instructors coming only once or twice a year may be given exceptions to any or all of above by CCGC manager.
- Sporting clays instruction is limited to when the sporting clay course is open and available. Sporting Clay course hours are posted on website and at the clubhouse.

Non-members who do not have a liability waiver signed on file in club house may only be instructed when the clubhouse is open. All non-members must purchase tokens at non-member rates.

If instruction is given at times when the club is closed instructors are required to have their students pick up all spent hulls on the field, roll up pull cord, release/turn off machines and fill machines with targets prior to leaving. Instructors are encouraged to teach their students proper etiquette by having their students place their hulls in hull buckets even when CCGC is open.

Each instructor will provide a copy of a current Certificate of Liability Insurance for a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence. The certificate will identify the named instructor and show CCGC as an additional insured.

Each Instructor will provide a copy of their current Instructor's License/certification. Certificates will need to be current and from recognized organizations or agencies and state the individual is qualified to be an instructor or coach for the firearm(s) to be taught. Certificates from the following are acceptable:

- The National Skeet Shooting Assoc., the National Sporting Clay Assoc., NRA (for shotgun specific certificate), 4H Coaching Certificate.

CCGC is not responsible or liable for any equipment or items left on the premises. With my signature below, I hereby release any and all claims against the Corpus Christi Gun Club resulting from my participation in or as a spectator of firearms shooting activities, including any claims caused by the negligence of the Corpus Christi Gun Club. I have read the release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement and fully understand its contents and signed it of my own free will.
